
Saddle mounts to your CBR just like stock with brackets preinstalled on the Corbin seats.

- 1. Remove stock seats.
- 2. **Front Saddle:** Simply slide the saddle onto the bike nose first engaging the tongue. Lower the seat into position and secure to the bike with the stock bolts under the corners of the seat. Tighten to 4-6 ft. lbs. (*Figure 1*)
- 3. Rear Saddle or Smuggler: Installs like stock with latch pin preinstalled that integrates with your CBR key lock. Simply slide the rear bracket into the tail section, align the front latch mechanism to the stock locking system and push down until you hear it click. (Figure 2)
- 4. To release the rear saddle or smuggler, use the stock key on the left side of the bike. (Figure 3)

**NOTE:** When installing the H-6RR-5-R on a 1000 RR, you will need to use the 1/8" nylon washers to space the latch down and let the latch catch onto the locking system.
