




- 1. Start by removing your stock seat. To do this, remove the three bolts from the chassis by using a T50 torx wrench, then pull out the seat (*Figure 1*).
- 2. Next, remove the two self locking nuts and flat washers from the bracket under the seat by using a 17mm wrench (Figure 2).
- 3. Remove four Allen bolts in the middle of the baseplate, using a 3mm Allen wrench (*Figure 3*).
- 4. Remove the other three bolts on the base plate, using a T15 torx wrench (*Figure 4*).
- 5. Remove the baseplate from the stock seat and transfer it onto the Corbin seat and secure with the provided Allen bolts, using a 3/32 Allen wrench.
- 6. Re-install the mounting bracket and secure with the stock self locking nuts and washers.
- 7. Install the Corbin seat onto the chassis by securing it with the stock torx bolts.
