Saddles mount to your Yamaha just like stock with brackets preinstalled on the Corbin seats. Latching is secure with your stock key-lock.

1. Remove stock seat.

2. **Front Saddle:** Slide the front tongue into the bracket at the base of the gas tank, then align the rear of the saddle to the rear mounting bracket and push down until it locks. *(Figure 2)*

NOTE: If using Corbin's rear saddle or smuggler trunk, the front saddle must be installed first.

3. **Rear Saddle:** If you will be using the rider's backrest on the rear saddle, install it before latching seat to bike. There is a safety screw that must be installed and you cannot reach it with the seat mounted on. The rear saddle install by slipping the front tongues under the brackets, align with rear lock and push down. (*Figure 3*)

4. **Smuggler Trunk:** The smuggler trunk installs by slipping the front tongues under the crossing center bracket then align with rear lock and push down. *(Figure 3)*

NOTE: The mounting bracket on the Corbin saddle is opposite from the stock saddle.

NOTE: When installing the smuggler trunk, open the lid to the smuggler, then push down on the base to lock in place.

4. To release the rear saddle & smuggler trunk, use the stock key on the left side of the bike.

NOTE: The front and rear brackets can be adjusted.
