**NOTE:** We recommend the use of Loctite® or similar thread lock product when assembling parts on your motorcycle.

1. Start by removing the two bolts on the fender struts (*Figure 1*), using a 6mm hex key. Discard the bolts.

2. Replace the fender rail bolts with the supplied stainless steel studs and spacers (Figure 2), using a 5/8" wrench. Use Loctite® and tighten to 12 ft. lbs.

Remove the left side passenger footpeg with a 12 mm socket wrench.

4. With the footpeg bracket removed, install the supplied lower mounting bracket (#A00983) between the frame and the footpeg. Secure with the stock bolts *(Figure 3)*. Use Loctite® and tighten to 18 ft. lbs.

5. On the right side, remove the bolt on the exhaust hanger with a 6mm hex key. Discard the bolt, but you will be reusing the flat washer

6. Secure the exhaust hanger with the stock washer, the supplied spacer and stainless steel stud (*Figure 4*). Use Loctite® and tighten to 12 ft. lbs.








7. Remove the license plate hanger (*Figure 5*). Discard bracket and bolts.

8. Now install Corbin bracket (#A00984) and secure it with the supplied m6 x 1 x m16 flat head screw, flat washer and nylock nut (*Figure 6*). Use Loctite® and tighten to 8 ft. lbs.


9. You are now ready to install the saddlebags. Carefully align the bags with the four mounting studs and secure with a flat washer, lock washer and chrome acorn nut (*Figure 7*). Use Loctite® and tighten to 8 ft. lbs.


10. Reinstall your license plate onto the two threaded barrels on the Corbin bracket #A00984.

11. That's it, you're ready to roll. Have a great ride and keep the Corbin side up!
